

INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM UNDER TECHNICAL COOPERATION SCHEME OF COLOMBO PLAN

The A total of eleven training programs have been sanctioned by Ministry of Finance, Dept. of Economic Affairs, New Delhi under the Technical Cooperation Scheme of Colombo Plan to impart training to 23 member countries. The member countries are

Afghanistan, Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Burma, Cambodia, Fiji, Indonesia, Iran , India, Japan, Loas, Maldives, Malaysia, Nepal, New Zealand, Philippines, Papua New Guinea, Pakistan, Singapore, South Korea, Sri Lanka and Thailand.

How to Apply

Candidates wishing to apply for the training program must go through the following instructions.

- The candidates should apply through Indian Mission / Embassy in their country which have the details of the present training programme (and also various other programmes).
- The nominations should be in the prescribed format (Form A.2-3) which is available with the Indian Missions / Embassies.
- The nominations so received will be scrutinized by the Indian Missions / Embassies and sent to MoF, DEA, Govt.of India which in turn will process these nominations with our Institute. The institute, after determining the suitability of the candidates, will invite them through the Indian Missions / Embassies.
- The air passage will be arranged by the Indian Missions/Embassies.
- Due to limited number of places, early receipt of application is encouraged. It will, therefore, be in the interest of the applicants that applications in complete shape are forwarded to MoF, DEA, at least six weeks prior to the commencement of the training program.
